One could sense the crowd becoming a bit anxious as we waited for our loved ones to appear.

As I continued to watch I heard the whisper of Holy Spirit, "If only my Church were watching for me like that." I heard him as clearly as if you and I were speak-

ing face to face. Refocusing my attention, I saw a different crowd this time. Though they consisted of the same young and old, male and female, representing many different nations and languages, Holy Spirit referred to them as "my Church".
