





## Reapers in the Rain and more rain

October is rainy season in Honduras, a valuable tidbit of information to remember when traveling there! Really not the best weather for outdoor services, it was wet, really wet .....and wonderful. Where to begin in a nation of a million stories told mostly by young men and women who have had to deal with adult situations since their early childhood.

I worked with PAOC missionaries, Randy and Judy Lundrigan and Alvin Anderson from Manos Extendidas. Between preaching indoor and outdoor services, schools, youth prison and a leadership conference we managed to stay busy. Many nights, we had the privilege to pray with people for salvation, healing, deliverance and direction. It was exciting to share the gospel with 700 plus kids in two schools along with donating supplies to the teachers. In the grade 5-6 classes I used a 'witness bracelet' as a tool to explain the need of salvation. At the conclusion of each class, I asked the students who wanted to give their lives to Christ to put the bracelet on as a sign of their commitment. Very moving as many tied the bracelet around their wrist.

I spoke at a youth prison to those in population and to gang members who are confined to their own wing. There I met a young man, by the name of Esso. He was sent to prison as a hit man by one of the gangs to kill three inmates. Instead, Esso was gloriously saved and now serves the Lord as an Evangelist leading many young men to the Lord while he finishes his sentence.

The two day leadership conference was amazing as 40 plus leaders came together for a time of teaching on marriage, pastoring and evangelism. The need for leadership material, teaching and fellowship is monumental. Formal education finishes at grade six and I know of no Bible College in the country. I look forward to returning to Honduras
