The reality is less than four percent of our communities will ever attend the buildings where we worship and only two percent invite someone to attend their church. Do the math! Our church seniors are tired of the next, latest and greatest and our young people no longer see the North American church as relevant to reach the lost. It's not another program we need or another method, nothing borrowed just something born of the Spirit and birthed in your spirit.
