While in Honduras we held and hosted, Pastors and Leadership Conferences, Missions Day Away, radio, church services, visited schools and a prison chapel.

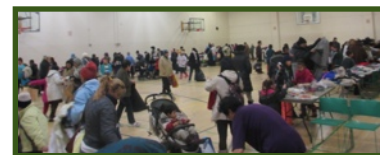
