THE FRUIT REMAINS

In March I returned to Trinidad & Tobago for the eleventh time after a two year absence. After the completion and dedicated of Bethel Open Bible in 2012 I felt it was time to move on for a season.



Over the 18 days of ministry in churches, tent meetings and schools I could see and sense the faithfulness of God on so many levels. I met people that were saved and healed over the years in our meetings.

I met a young man who was saved at a tent crusade four years ago. I remember the night as I gave three altar calls with no response. Asked again and seven young men walked forward to accept Christ, he was one of them.

I met another man who worked with the different teams from Canada on the church building in Borde Narve. When I gave the altar call a few weeks ago, in the church he helped build, he walked forward for prayer.

I met another man who was an alcoholic. The hospital sent him home to die. His wife came forward in one of the tent meetings three years ago and asked if I would pray for her husband, he needed a miracle. We did, God saved him, healed him and he is back at work. He and his wife heard I was back in the area and came to one of the services to say 'Thanks' for praying.

I always like to buy a few little gifts for the family before returning home. While shopping in San Fernando I chatted with the store owner and invited her to attend the evening service. She came and was the first to raise her hand for prayer as I gave the altar call.

Now that I am getting older I think about it more, the importance of reproducing your faith in the lives of others. It was good to see that the seed planted over the years through Reapers has grown and remains strong.

READY FOR REVIVAL

I returned to Cuba last January to speak at a pastors conference in the City of Cienfuegos, as well as, preach in local churches. It amazes me to see the tremendous growth taking place among the Cuban Assemblies of God churches especially under Communism. The Cuban Constitution guarantees religious freedom on paper but is rather restrictive in practice. Yet the Cuban Pentecostal Church has grown from 300 in the mid 1980's to 6000 plus local assemblies.

Their church buildings run from a simple room in a house to a plaster church sanctuary. They seem to have more members than seating. Many stand throughout the service or shift off with a family



member for a few minutes on a chair. Their worship instruments are dated and worn but it doesn't matter as the singing is explosive and passionate. When you preach they pull the word out of you like water from a sponge. Many hold their bibles like a prized possession not knowing how to find the text but are hungry for truth. And the altar times are charged with the presence of God.
