They have a saying in Cuba: "No money, no materials, no permission". You need all three to get the job done. We hauled as many tools as we could carry as they are extremely limited. It's amazing to see what creative minds can come up when there is so little. The rebar was delivered dragged behind a motorcycle, 600 concrete blocks were delivered and stacked by the boys, and mortar was mixed by hand without complaining.

My week was less strenuous, speaking at a Pastors Conference and church services. The intensity in worship is overwhelming. I wanted to take a few pictures during worship without being disruptive to the flow of the service. It was easy as no one had their eyes open to see what I or anyone else was doing.

I plan on being in Cuba four times this year to continue to equip, empower, encourage and evangelize.
